## High School Program

The High School Program prepares students to earn their high school diploma; improve their basic literacy & math skills; and/or pass a High School Equivalency Exam (GED/HiSET). Classes are offered in the morning and evening (Monday-Thursday 8:00am -12:00pm or 5:00 pm – 9:00 pm) and through an online Independent Study option.

To enroll in the High School Program, you must first attend a mandatory orientation session. Please bring an official copy of your most recent high school transcript with you to orientation. An orientation session lasts approximately two hours.
